Then we hope you'll work with us to apply your experience to improving the LA County child welfare system. Our recommendations include:

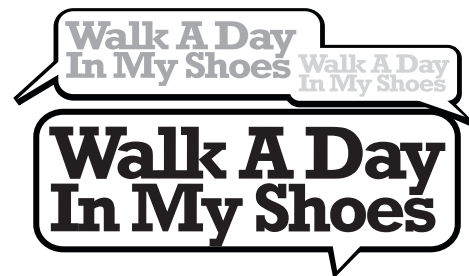
- The resources we need to do quality social work like access to computers, phones, fax machines and copy machines.
