
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

FAQ'S

Below lists frequently asked questions regarding the SEIU - County of Riverside College Scholarship.

- Q. How many scholarships will be awarded each year?
 - A. The number of scholarships awarded each year will vary from year to year depending upon the funding available.
- Q. Do I have to be a graduating high school senior to apply?
 - A. Current legally dependent college students working towards their first undergraduate degree may also apply in addition to graduating high school seniors.
- Q. Is there a grade point average (G.P.A.) minimum requirement to apply?
 - A. Yes. You must have a minimum *3.00 cumulative Weighted G.P.A.* to apply for the scholarship.
- O. Who can I obtain a letter of recommendation from?
 - A. Your letter of recommendation will be accepted from anyone (other than a family member) who is familiar with you and your accomplishments.
- Q. When and how will the scholarship winners be notified?
 - A. Notification letters will be mailed no later than July 26, 2017.
- Q. How will the winners receive their award?
 - A. Scholarship winners will be required to provide official transcripts and college enrollment documentation in order to receive their scholarship award. Winners will be provided with this information at the time of the award notification.
- Q. How long do I have to claim my scholarship monies, if awarded?
 - A. If awarded, you will have one academic year to claim your scholarship monies. For example, if you are awarded the scholarship for the 2017/2018 academic year, you must claim your monies prior to June 30, 2018.
- O. Do I have to attend college locally?
 - A. No. You can attend college out of state if you choose.
- Q. Can I receive the scholarship more than once?
 - A. Yes.
- Q. If I applied in a previous year for this scholarship, but was not awarded, can I apply this year?
 - A. Yes.
- Q. As a parent, I have more than one eligible dependent. Can they each submit an application?
 - A. Yes. All legal dependents meeting the criteria outlined are eligible to apply.
- Q. Who can I contact with any questions I may have?

- Q. How are scholarships awarded?
 - A. Scholarships are not based on financial need. Scholarships are based on a combination of merit, community service, recommendation letter, and other criteria.
