Internal Pay Inequity

Pay rates for a classification or occupational group that are out of alignment with pay rates of other classifications or occupational groups within the same employer

Examples of Internal Pay Inequities:

- Comparable experience & education requirements
- Differential between supe and base
- Gender-based (custodian v housekeeper example)
